Diploma in Public Health 3 YEARS	Candidates must pass English Language with a minimum symbol D. Three (3) credits must come from Agriculture, Biology, Geography, Mathematics, Consumer Science, and Physics or physical Science. Two (2) other passes must come from History, Literature in English, Religious Knowledge, Design and Technology, and SiSwati.	BSc Disaster Risk Reduction & Management 4 YEARS	Candidates must have a minimum average of 35 points. Six (6) credits including English, Geography, Science, Biology, Mathematics and any two other subjects. Qualification: SGCSE/IGCSE/GCE O'Level / Matric / AS Level. Diploma or Associate Degree holders in DRRM may be admitted into Level 3 (subject to verification).
Diploma in Occupational Safety & Health 2 YEARS	Candidates must pass English Language with a minimum symbol D. Three (3) credits with symbol C or better come from Biology, Biological Sciences and Chemistry/Physical science. Two (2) other passes must come from Mathematics, Physics, Home Science, or Agriculture.	BSc Public Health 4 YEARS	Minimum of six (6) credits at GCE O'Level / IGCSE/ SGCSE/Matric. Credits at C grade or better in English Language and Mathematics. Any two of the following: Biology, Physics, Science (Physics/Chemistry), Human & Social Biology, Combined Science. Plus two additional subjects or recognized equivalent qualification. Diploma in Public Health (Credit or higher) may qualify for direct entry into Year 3. International qualifications must be verified by EQA.
Diploma in Disaster Risk Reduction & Management 3 YEARS	Candidates must pass English Language and Agriculture with a minimum symbol D. Three (3) credits must come from Biology, Geography, Physics, Mathematics, Consumer Science, or physical Science. One (1) other passes must come from History, Literature in English, Religious Knowledge, Design and Technology, and SiSwati.	BSc Occupational Safety & Health 4 YEARS	Minimum of six (6) credits including English Language, Mathematics and any Science subject. Qualification: SGCSE/IGCSE / GCE O'Level / COSC or equivalent. OR Holder of Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health or Environmental Health. OR Holder of Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health or Environmental Health. OR Any other recognized equivalent qualification.
Diploma in Emergency medical care & rescue 3 YEARS	A minimum (Average) of 30 points for Form 5 qualified prospective students. Biology, Physics and Chemistry will be added advantage. Employed prospective students without form 5, will have to apply for Recognized Prior Learning (RPL). The applicant should then: Pass the fitness assessment Pass an interview with the college rep.	Bsc in Emergency medical care & rescue 4 YEARS	Candidates must have a minimum average of 35 points. Six (6) credits including English, Geography, Science, Biology, Mathematics and any two other subjects. Qualification: SGCSE/IGCSE/GCE O'Level / Matric / AS Level. Diploma or Associate Degree holders in EMC may be admitted into Level 3 (subject to verification).
